Entry Information & Rules

- Application must be received 10 days before tournament. This will go by postmark date.
 - \$10.00 Entry Fee / Checks made out to PA. Bass Nation
- There will be <u>no volunteer gas money given out</u> since entry fee is only \$10.00 a team and teams fish with their own adviser.
- Must have \$300,000.00 in boat owner liability insurance. This will be checked at meeting. If it cannot be produced then the team the boat volunteer signed up with will not be permitted to fish.
- Boat Volunteer must sign waiver form if not an active member of Pa. Bass
 Nation and it must be returned with application.
- Youth photo release must be signed and returned with application. One for each angler
- No cell phone use during tournament by participants unless it's an emergency. The cell phone ban covers texting, incoming and outgoing phone calls. Disqualification of team for violation and entry fees will not be returned.
- Trolling motor must be operated by youth participants unless there are dangerous conditions.
- Buddy Tournament Format. Team will fish together with their adult adviser. Rules on what the adviser can and cannot do will be announced at morning meeting.
- Alternates or team members cannot be a part of any other team that has qualified to fish the High School/Youth state championship.
